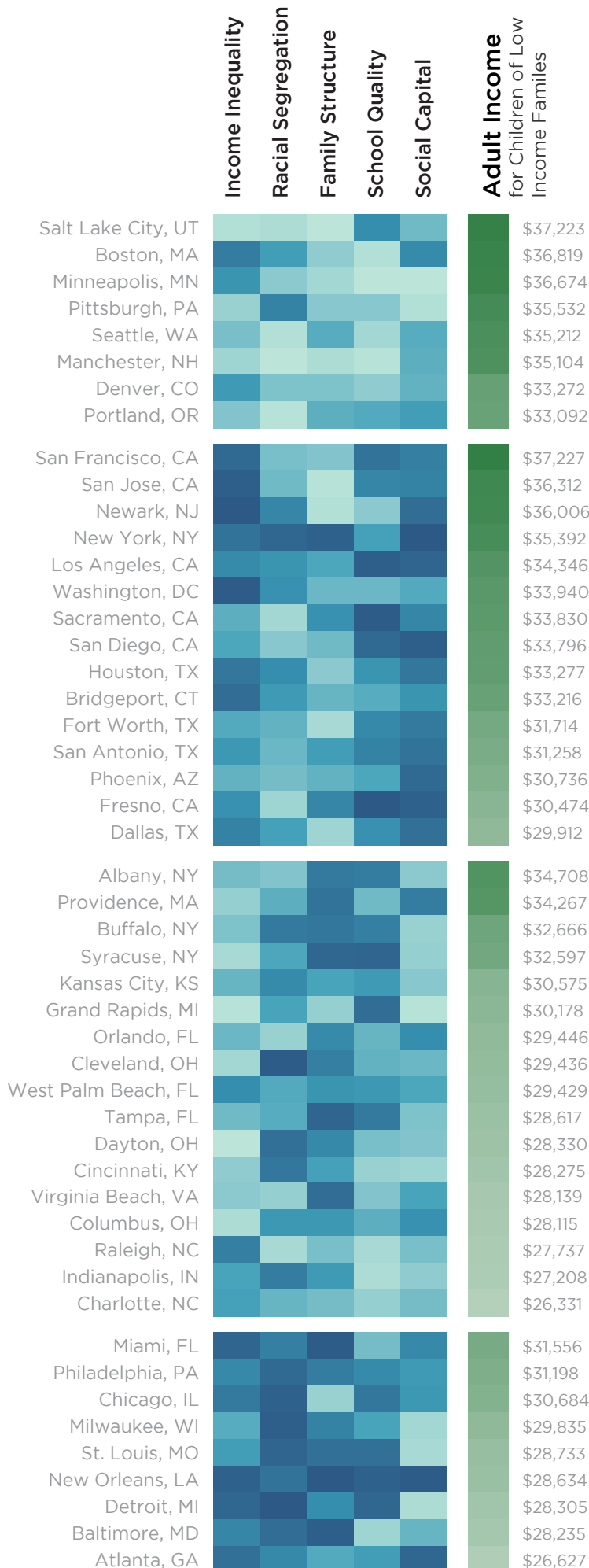


Cluster Analysis Five Strongest Indicators

Top 50 Largest Commuting Zones



CLUSTER 1

White Northern cities

Generally high mobility driven by high ranks on most measures; characterized by low Black populations.

CLUSTER 2

Diverse Coastal and Southwestern cities

Have relatively high rates of mobility despite high levels of income inequality, low levels of social capital and poor schools. Characterized by their diversity and large Latino populations.

CLUSTER 3

White Midwestern and Southern Cities

Low rates of mobility despite average scores on most measures. Within-cluster rankings driven mainly by differences in income inequality and racial composition.

CLUSTER 4

Mid-sized Black Cities

Low rates of mobility with especially high levels of income inequality and segregation. Social capital not a factor. Characterized by high Black populations.
